  Martin Luther King Jr. fought racism in the United States. (*no preposition*)
- 6. I congratulate you <u>on</u> passing all your courses.
- 7. This store specializes **in** European food and wine.
- Married couples sometimes fight <u>about</u> money.
  ("Over money" is also possible, but "about" makes more sense.)
- 9. Not getting enough sleep interferes with your ability to think clearly.
- 10. Can you distinguish between Mandarin and Cantonese Chinese?
- 11. Pedro and Elizabeth are fighting **<u>about</u>** who is going to do the dishes tonight.
- 12. Carlos is fighting <u>against</u> a serious illness.Carlos is fighting a serious illness. (*no preposition*)
