## Answer Key

1. I think George is home. I can hear his car. (no preposition)
2. I need to talk **to** my teacher **about** the assignment.
3. When class starts, students need to stop using their smartphones. (no preposition)
4. The little boy is showing his room **to** his new friend.
5. You can hear **about** the weather on the radio.
6. The teacher asked the students to stop talking. (no prepositions)
7. To choose the right hotel, think **of** the price, location, room size, and so on.  
(The preposition “about” is also correct, but “of” is better in this context.)
8. I always listen **to** music on the radio when I drive.
9. I always think **of** my children when I’m traveling.  
(The preposition “about” is also correct, but “of” is better in this context.)
10. We’re going to meet **with** our boss to discuss our plans.  
(Using no preposition is also correct, but using “with” is better in this context.)
11. I have to show my homework **to** the teacher tomorrow.
12. Can we talk **about** the situation?

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
