



Summary of the Writing Process

(Basic, A-Level)

Stage 1. Think	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Generate ideas (come up with many possible ideas)<input type="checkbox"/> Select one idea (idea that you have enough to discuss but not too much)<input type="checkbox"/> Decide on your main point (what you are going to tell, discuss, inform, argue, explain, or list, and so on)<input type="checkbox"/> Plan your writing (what you are going to put in your product)
Stage 2. Write	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Organize your ideas (formal or informal outline)<input type="checkbox"/> Write your product (email, paragraph, short story, longer passage, and so on)
Stage 3. Polish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Revise your work (focus on the content)<input type="checkbox"/> Edit your work (focus on grammar, punctuation, spelling, and so on)<input type="checkbox"/> Check all final details (formatting, submitting, printing, and so on)
