Instructions. Based on <u>this lesson about dependent and independent clauses</u>, combine each pair of sentences to build a single, more complex sentence including an independent and a dependent clause. (In some cases, you may be able to <u>omit the verb "be"</u> in the dependent clause.)

Example 1: The toy has already broken down. We bought it yesterday.

Your sentence 1: The toy (that) we bought yesterday has already broken down.

Example 2: The woman was John's daughter. I was talking to her at the party.

Your sentence 2: The woman I was talking to was John's daughter.

When you are done, see "Answer Key" to check your answers.

Also correct (very formal): The woman to whom I was talking was Professor Ecks's daughter.

- 9. Two of the experiments (that) the researchers conducted yielded interesting results.
- 10. The library that the tornado destroyed last year is now the newest building in town.
